### **CITZ 7000 Preparation for Citizenship**

### 15.0 - 90.0 hours

Acceptable for credit: N - Noncredit C-ID Course Number: N/A

Students learn about the Constitution, government, history, and geography of the United States in preparation for the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) required oral interview and exam. The class also familiarizes students with requirements and exclusions for citizenship. (Fall, Spring, Summer) (Noncredit)

# CITZ 7001 U.S. Citizenship Interview Preparation

#### **18.0 - 24.0 hours** Acceptable for credit: N - Noncredit

This course is designed as an addition to the citizenship preparation course. Citizenship applicants must pass a face-toface interview with an immigration officer in order to qualify for citizenship. In this course, topics will cover the N-400 application questions and how to answer them. Students will practice basic English conversational skills, as well as key definitions of the words used in the application. (Satisfactory Progress)
