Limitations on Enrollment: To participate in this course, (1) the student must be working at a job within their major; (2) the student must be able to become involved in new or expanded responsibilities on the job; (3) the employer must be willing to cooperate with Allan Hancock College in the supervision and evaluation of the student; and (4) the student must attend all coordination/consultation meetings in addition to other work and course responsibilities. Students enrolled in NURX 7149 may earn up to 120 (unpaid placement) - 150 (paid placement) hours. These hours will count towards a maximum of 480 (unpaid) - 600 (paid) hours.

Supervised employment extending career and technical education program-based learning in Health Sciences including but not limited to medical assisting, nursing assisting, etc. to an on-the-job learning environment related to the student's career and educational goals.
